Pooled Money Investment Account Monthly Portfolio Composition ⁽¹⁾ 06/30/22 \$234.5 billion

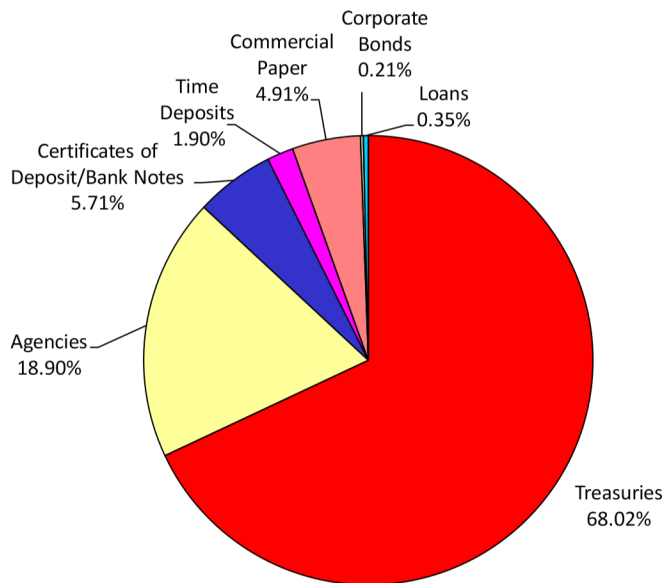
