Subject: Delinquent Accounts Due to COVID-19

At the July 2021 Board Meeting, the Board requested a letter with assistance options be sent to all customers with arrearage amounts in excess of \$200.00. This letter was mailed to both landlords and tenants. Staff received some positive feedback from customers, however the District has not received any payments promised by these programs offering assistance to date.

Customers requesting to dispute late charges with the Board were advised that they may need to provide the Board with proof that they applied for and were denied funds with the programs listed on the letter.

Two customers have asked to appear before the Board and are disputing late fees on their accounts. The first customer on the agenda, Zia Faruqui (Account No. 055-6701-00) has a balance of \$3,194.57 of which \$1,411.50 is for penalties. Since March 2020, there have been 2 payments totaling \$219.10 on the account. The second customer is a landlord, Michael Morgan (Tenant Account No. 014-8018-19). Mr. Morgan's tenant has a balance of \$2,267.44 of which \$565.85 is for penalties. Since March 2020, the tenant has made 4 payments. Mr. Morgan has agreed to a payment arrangement of \$75 plus current charges to be made each month starting this past July in order to avoid accruing any further penalties on the account.

Both customers were given a one-time courtesy past due penalty adjustment. All parties listed have current mailing addresses and have been receiving their bills as well as landlord copy bills. These properties have also received a hang notice each month which does show the account balance and fee assessed. Staff recommends upholding District policy, however Staff does recognize the extraordinary hardship COVID-19 has placed on everyone. Staff recommends the Board consider waiving 25% of the past due penalties if the customer pays the account in full within 7 days. This would offer customers an incentive to pay off their balances and assist the District in collecting these large outstanding balances as quickly as possible. Staff also recommends that if the Board elects to make such an offer to these two customers that it will be offered to all customers with large account balances due to COVID-19.
